ORDINANCE

**APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A 2020 AARP COMMUNITY
CHALLENGE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000.00 FOR THE U.S.
HIGHWAY 90 UNDERPASS BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT, A PROJECT
THAT ACTIVATES A NEW PUBLIC SPACE AND IMPROVES THE
INTERSECTION UNDERNEATH U.S. HIGHWAY 90 AT MISSION
ROAD AND STEVES AVENUE.**

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WHEREAS, the 2020 AARP Community Challenge Grant provides small grants to fund “quick-action” projects that can help communities become more livable for people of all ages. Eligible projects should aim to improve housing, transportation, public space, technology (“smart cities”), civic engagement, and more; and

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2020, the AARP National Office notified the World Heritage Office that its grant application was selected to receive a 2020 AARP Community Challenge Grant for \$30,000.00 for the U.S. Highway 90 Underpass Beautification Project. The World Heritage Office request include the installation of bench seating and interpretive design concepts to activate the new public space and beautify the U.S. Highway 90 underpass at Mission Road (Word Heritage Trail) and Steves Avenue; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. City Council hereby authorizes the acceptance of funds from AARP in the amount of \$30,000.00 for the U.S. Highway 90 Underpass Beautification Project.

SECTION 2. Funds are authorized to be received from AARP to fund 45099000, SAP Project Definition 23-01781 World Heritage Underpass Infrastructure Project. The budget shall be revised by increasing WBS Element 23-01781-90-10-01 AARP, GL Account 6101100, and WBS Element 23-01781-05-02-08 Construction -AARP Grant, GL Account 5201140 Constructions Cost, by the amount of \$ 30,000.00.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective ten days after its passage.
