AN ORDINANCE 2020-08-20-0553

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (SAOEM) TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT. AND APPROPRIATE. **UPON** AWARD, UP TO\$1,300,000.00 2020 **STATE HOMELAND FROM** THE SECURITY **PROGRAM** (SHSP) **AND AUTHORIZES** PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT OF 1 POSITION.

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division (HSGD) has grant funds available from the 2020 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP), a program that is designed to enhance the State's ability to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of international terrorism and "all hazards" disasters impacting the AACOG region which encompasses the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, and the surrounding 13 counties and suburban cities within these counties; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Office of Emergency Management (SAOEM) wishes to apply for grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,300,000.00 to accomplish that purpose; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance also approves personnel complement of one (1) position to be funded for a period of one year upon award; and

WHEREAS, the grant period would be October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, an award of this grant would not require a cash matching or in-kind contribution; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC) or designee, is hereby authorized to submit a grant application and accept grant funds upon award in an amount up to \$1,300,000.00 from the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division (HSGD), for the period of be October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021 to fund the following State Homeland Security Grant Projects (SHSP):

- 1. Law Enforcement Regional Response Capabilities
- 2. Fire Services Regional Response Capabilities
- 3. Homeland Security Strategic Planning
- 4. Southwest Texas Regional Fusion Center
- 5. City's Cyber Security Prevention Initiative

A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Office of Emergency Management. The City Manager or designee, or the Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC) or designee, are hereby authorized to accept said grant, if awarded under the same terms and conditions as applied for. The City Manager or designee, or the Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC) or designee, are further authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance of the grant award. A letter addressed to HSGD authorizing the submission of an application for grant funds, the designation of a point of contact for the City of San Antonio, and the execution of all necessary documents is attached hereto as **ATTACHMENT I**.

SECTION 2. The City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of San Antonio to accept said grant. The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the awarded SHSP funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the HSGD in full. The City Council designates the Emergency Management Coordinator, Office of Emergency Management (OEM), as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 3. Upon approval of this ordinance, a new fund and internal order number will be created. A final budget will be provided upon the award of the grant funds, upon which the above sum will be appropriated from EMC.

SECTION 4. A personnel complement of one (1) Sr. Management Coordinator position is approved as identified in **ATTACHMENT II**.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by eight (8) or more affirmative votes of the City Council. If less than eight (8) affirmative votes are received, then this Ordinance shall be effective ten (10) days after passage.
