The City of San Antonio, Aviation Department needs to procure OAG Aviation Worldwide flight view data feeds to support San Antonio International Airport's new Common Use Passenger Processing System (CUPPS). As designed and implemented at SAT, the CUPPS is coded for integration with the OAG. As a result, the CUPPS can only work with OAG data feeds and OAG is the sole source. The OAG data will assist the Aviation Department with better handling of current and future airline movement and scheduling between and among the terminal gates.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with OAG Aviation Worldwide LLC which will cost approximately \$ 120,014.00
