Because this software is proprietary from Siemens, the City of San Antonio IT department cannot update or perform software/hardware maintenance to the program. The Facility Maintenance Department currently has a sole source contract # 4400003714 with Siemens to have an on-call Siemens Automation Specialist available for routine maintenance and to troubleshoot software issues for Aviation for five years that will expire on 08/31/2020. In addition, the Specialist will also repair and update analog and digital equipment that is tied to the Siemens APOGEE system. Going forward Aviation is requesting a replacement sole source contract through an RFO with Siemen's to include an upgrade of the server software to the new Desigo CC (\$112K) and to continue maintenance and repair for the
