ORDINANCE

RATIFYING THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO AN AGREEMENT WITH TRIPLE P AMERICA, INC., FOR THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT'S VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM TO ADJUST THE TRAINING, ACCOMPANYING MATERIALS AND COMPENSATION IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$180,801.85 FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TRIPLE P PROGRAM IN SAN ANTONIO FOR A TERM BEGINNING FEBRUARY 1, 2020 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020.

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WHEREAS, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's (Metro Health's) Violence Prevention Program aims to prevent violence and violence-related deaths in the community; and

WHEREAS, as part of a comprehensive approach to stopping violence before it starts, Metro Health will be implementing the Triple P Parenting Program to support positive parenting and reduce child abuse; and

WHEREAS, San Antonio has the highest rate of confirmed child abuse cases of all major metropolitan Texas cities; and

WHEREAS, treating violence as a public health issue and requiring both immediate treatments to stop the detriment and long-term systems change to prevent the causes of violence is an urgent community need; and

WHEREAS, the Triple P Parenting Program is one of only two programs identified to work at a population level to reduce child abuse and maltreatment, and it is rated as the top parenting program in the world by the United Nations; and

WHEREAS, the Triple P Parenting Program utilizes a multi-level integrated system of interventions to support a change of population norms and practices; and

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic Metro Health seeks approval of an amendment to the agreement with Triple P America, Inc. to adjust the training, accompanying materials and compensation to Triple P America, Inc. for the implementation of the Triple P America Program in San Antonio; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The execution of an amendment to an agreement with Triple P America, Inc., for the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's Violence Prevention Program to adjust the training, accompanying materials and compensation in an amount up to \$180,801.85 for the implementation of the Triple P Program in San Antonio for a term beginning February 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2020 is hereby ratified. A copy of the amendment is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$99,518.00 for this Ordinance is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 3618010008 and General Ledger Account 5201040 as part of the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget adopted by City Council.

SECTION 3. Funding in the amount of \$81,283.85 for this Ordinance is available in Fund 2202236006, Internal Order 136000000773 and General Ledger Account 5201040 as part of the Healthy Start Grant adopted by City Council.

SECTION 4. Payment in the amount up to \$180,801.85 is authorized to Triple P America, Inc. and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
