IN-PERSON LEARNING TRACK

- Phase 1: Tuesday, September 8, 2020
 - Four six (4-6) students per classroom
 - Approximately 60 children/Center
- Phase 2: Planned for Monday, September 21, 2020
 - Additional 5-8 students
 - Up to 150/Center total enrollment
- Phase 3: Planned for Monday, October 5, 2020
 - Remaining children up to 10/room
 - Up to 250/Center total enrollment (1,000 total)




