ORDINANCE

**APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A THE
TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
COMPREHENSIVE SELECTIVE TRAFFIC
ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT FOR
\$900,000.00 FOR THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1,
2020 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2021.**

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WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDot) has a Comprehensive Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Grant for the period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021, in the amount of \$900,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the grant will be used to enhance traffic safety related to driving while intoxicated, speeding, occupant protection, distracted driving and intersection related violations; and

WHEREAS, this will be the twenty-first year TxDOT has offered this grant to SAPD; and

WHEREAS, this grant requires a General Fund cash-match of \$265,000.00 and in in-kind contribution of \$77,500.00, **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and designee, and the Chief of Police and designee, are hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount up to \$900,000.00 from the TxDot for the STEP grant for the grant period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021. A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Police Department.

SECTION 2. An in-kind match up to \$77,500.00, which will be fulfilled by the use of SAPD vehicles, and a cash match of \$265,000.00 from the General Fund, contingent upon the available funding in the fiscal year 2021 budget, are hereby approved.

SECTION 3. The City Manager and designee, or the Chief of Police and designee, are hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said acceptance.

SECTION 4. Upon award, a new fund and internal order will be created for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant and the amounts listed above totaling a sum not to exceed \$1,242,500.00 will be appropriated in said funds. A formal final budget which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
