## **ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, an offer was submitted by Safeware, Inc., to provide two Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) suits, helmets and accessories for the San Antonio Police Department, Emergency Operations Center, for a total cost of \$77,855.05; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(2), which provides for a procurement necessary to protect the public health or safety; and

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The offer submitted by Safeware, Inc., to provide two Explosive Ordnance Disposal suits, helmets and accessories for the San Antonio Police Department, Emergency Operations Center, for a total cost of \$77,855.05 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

**SECTION 2.** Current grant funding is available in General Ledger 5709080, and Internal Order Number 120000000170 and Fund 2206520007 entitled "2018 SHSP Homeland Security" for a total amount of \$77.855.05.

**SECTION 3.** Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Safeware, Inc., to provide the Police Department with two Explosive Ordnance Disposal suits, helmets and accessories upon issuance of a purchase order.
