SANDOVAL, ALFREDO MACIAS TAVERA, AND AIDA ANN ZARAGOZA AS PART-TIME MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGES FOR THE REMAINDER OF A TWO-YEAR TERM EXPIRING APRIL 30, 2022

WHEREAS, excluding the Presiding Judge Carla Obledo, there are currently nine full-time and five parttime Municipal Court Judges, appointed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the full-time and part-time Judges expired April 30, 2020, and they are "holding over" under Article XII, Section 160 of the City Charter and Section 20-5(9) of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Court Advisory Committee undertook the appointment process in the Fall of 2019, and met on several occasions into early 2020 to consider the applications and make recommendations for appointments; and

WHEREAS, the pandemic caused by COVID-19 disrupted this process before the City Council could act on the judicial appointments, and the Committee agreed to delay appointments of the judges until after the City budget was adopted; and

WHEREAS, after review and consideration of the qualifications and performance of the applicants for full- and part-time time Municipal Court Judges, the City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the City to appoint the Municipal Court Advisory Committee nominees as Judges; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following persons are reappointed to serve as full-time Municipal Court Judges for the City of San Antonio Municipal Court for the remainder of terms expiring April 30, 2022:

SECTION 3. Annual salaries for the full-time Judges are established at \$106,446.60. Compensation for part-time Judges is \$45.94 per hour worked. Life insurance and health and retirement benefits currently extended to City employees are extended to the full-time Judges.

SECTION 4. Funding in the amount of \$2,391,742.00 for this ordinance is available in Fund 11001000 as part of the Fiscal Year 2021 Adopted Budget approved by City Council as set out the table below.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes, or, in the event eight affirmative votes are not received, ten days after passage.
