







Background

Operated by Department of Human Services Since 1973

Approximately 700,000 hot, noon meals serve in congregate setting annually (Roughly 2,500 2,700 daily)

Adults, aged 60 and older, and their spouses eligible to participate in the program

Meals prepared and delivered through contracted vendor to 52 sites (pr€OVID) in San Antonio & Bexar County

Meals and services must comply with Federa Senior Nutrition Program grant requirements and Metro Health Food Safety Guidelines


