

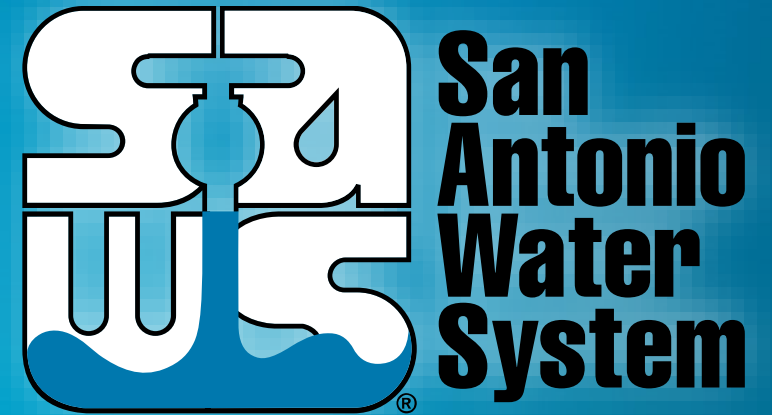

Over \$2.6 billion in SAWS Capital Projects in the next five years

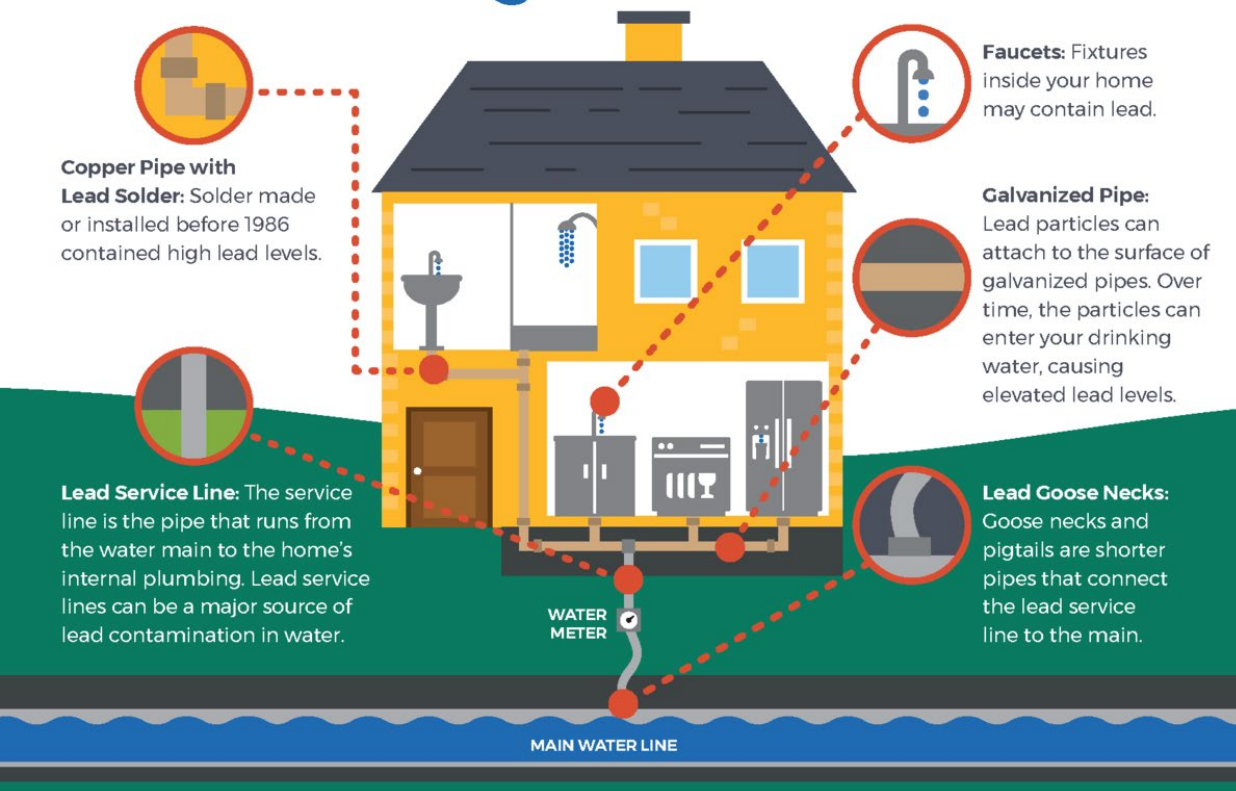

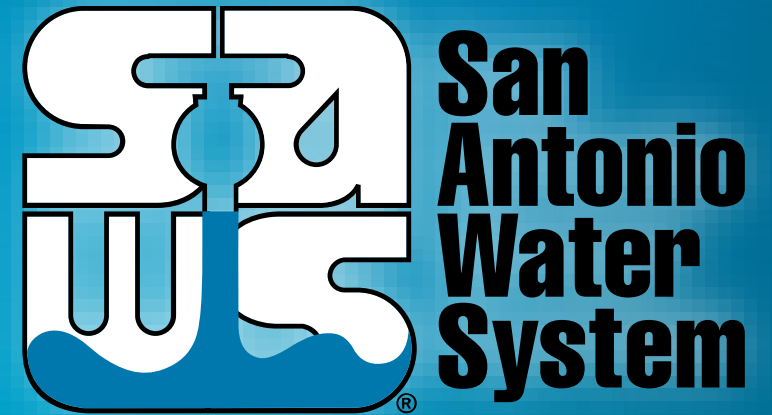
