

## **Solicitation Overview**

The demolition of the Taxiway (TW) R connector bridge, excavation, removal and disposal of buried municipal solid waste, and the backfill and sodding of the excavation with the following alternatives:

- (1) construction of full-strength concrete Taxiway pavement;
- (2) construction of asphalt shoulders along Taxiway;
- (3) demolition of a portion of the temporary Taxiway bypass for conversion to a vehicle service road;
- (4) new asphalt roadway connections; and,
- (5) mill and overlay of RW 13L-31R.
