ORDINANCE

EXTENDING CONTRACTS WITH LABOR ON DEMAND, INC., STABILITY STAFFING AND CONSULTING, LLC, AND TRI-STARR PERSONNEL, LLC, DBA TRI-STARR GROUP, FOR AN ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR PERIOD TO PROVIDE TEMPORARY STAFFING SERVICES FOR CITY DEPARTMENTS FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$2,821,086.00. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE IN THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENTS' FY 2021 ADOPTED BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2015-11-19-0973, passed and approved on November 19, 2015, the City entered into three professional services agreements with Labor on Demand, Inc., Stability Staffing and Consulting, LLC, and Tri-Starr Personnel, LLC, dba Tri-Starr Group, which terminate on December 20, 2020; and

WHEREAS, extension of the temporary staffing services contracts is requested for one year due to delays related to the coronavirus (COVID-19) and for staff to evaluate and prepare the next temporary staffing services Request for Proposals (RFP); and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The contract amendments with Labor on Demand, Inc., Stability Staffing and Consulting, LLC, and Tri-Starr Personnel, LLC, dba Tri-Starr Group, for a one-year period to provide temporary staffing services for City departments for an estimated annual cost of \$2,821,086.00 are hereby approved, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The City Manager, or designee, and the Director of the Human Resources Department are hereby authorized to execute the contract amendments which are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2021 budget, and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contracts through their terms as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
