ORDINANCE

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH CORDICO, INC., TO PROVIDE MOBILE APPLICATION SOFTWARE TO ENHANCE THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND WELLBEING SERVICES PROVIDED TO SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES AND THEIR FAMILIES FOR A COST OF \$49,500.00 ANNUALLY FOR A THREE YEAR TERM WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO, ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR PERIODS. THE INITIAL SUBSCRIPTION-BASED SERVICES, IMPLEMENTATION COSTS AND ON-GOING SUBSCRIPTION COSTS OF \$49,500.00 IS AVAILABLE FROM THE FY 2021 GENERAL FUND BUDGET. FUNDING FOR FUTURE FISCAL YEARS IS SUBJECT TO CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL OF THE ANNUAL BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, the City released a Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP) to provide delivery, implementation and maintenance of a subscription-based mobile application software to enhance the behavioral health and well-being services provided to San Antonio Fire Department (SAFD) employees and their families; and

WHEREAS, three proposal responses were received and evaluated; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends Cordico, Inc., for award of this contract; and

WHEREAS, approval of this ordinance will authorize a contract for a three-year initial term after implementation and include the option for the City to renew for two additional, one-year periods; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The proposal submitted by Cordico, Inc., for the delivery, implementation and maintenance of a subscription-based mobile application software in the amount of \$49,500.00 annually is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the score matrix and contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

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SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$49,500.00 is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 2015090001 and General Ledger 5201047 as part of the Fiscal Year 2021 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.
SECTION 3. Additional funding in the amount of \$198,000.00 for this ordinance is contingent upon City Council approval of the Fiscal Year 2022 and subsequent budgets that fall within the term of this contract.
SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.
SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
