Purpose

Participation in the State of Texas' Tobacco Enforcement Program ("TEP") to address and reduce the illegal sale or distribution of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, and tobacco products to persons who are younger than 21 years of age

- Conducting buys/stings

SAPD has applied and been awarded the TEP contract annually since FY 2011
