Lieutenant General Ronald Place Director, Defense Health Agency (DHA)





- Increase DHA's consolidated footprint in San Antonio
- Designate Brooke Army Medical Center (BAMC) as a "Trauma Center of Excellence"
- Continued support of the Secretary of the Army Designee (SECDES) Program
- Expand Uniformed Services University College of Allied Health Services locally

<u>Take-aways</u>

- LTG Place highly concerned about disproportionate costs they must pay in Texas (BAMC) for treating the uninsured
- DHA supporting AstraZeneca trials -- San Antonio one of three key markets
 - SA picked due to large Hispanic population -- DHA requested support for marketing and promoting trials to secure 1200 participants

- City's State legislative program addressing health service cost issue
- OMVA working with U.S. Army (ARNORTH) leadership regarding DHA site selection
- Request City's COVID-19 Response media team to promote DHA/AstraZeneca trials





General John Raymond Chief of Space Operations United States Space Force (USSF)



<u>"Asks"</u>

- Advocate for San Antonio to be location of HQ U.S. Space Command
- Consider San Antonio as first location of choice for new USSF missions/organizations

<u>Take-aways</u>

- Space Force is contemplating three new commands that will consider site selection within the next few years
- JBSA will be designated for a 5G pilot location
 - 5G supports US Space Command and US Space Force future efforts
 - 16th Air Force also critically important to space affairs

- Stay informed regarding new missions
- Will Space Command survive new administration?





Honorable James McPherson Under Secretary of the Army



<u>"Asks"</u>

- Department of Defense's 2022 & 2024 Warrior Games held in San Antonio
- Continuation/support of Secretary of the Army Designee Program (SECDES)
- Designate BAMC as a "Trauma Center of Excellence"
- Extended invite to visit BAMC -- learn more about local workforce programs and see first hand U.S. Army/City of San Antonio partnership

<u>Take-aways</u>

 Working through some personality conflicts b/w some staff leadership and United States Veterans Chamber of Commerce (leading Warrior Games proffer)

- OMVA works with Army North/United States Veterans Chamber of Commerce to secure Warrior Games in San Antonio
- Along with BAMC leadership, continue strong advocacy of SECDES Program





Honorable Robert Salesses Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Homeland Defense



<u>"Asks"</u>

- Meeting requested by the Mayor
- City would like continued/increased partnership/cooperation with the DoD in response to the COVID-19 crisis

<u>Take-aways</u>

- Salesses' staff considering how to further partner with the City
- Director, Defense Support of Civil Authorities interested in supporting Warrior Games in San Antonio

- SAEDF to connect Salesses' team to a community labs group
- OMVA follow-up regarding both Warrior Games and COVID-19 cooperation/partnership



Honorable Jennifer Miller Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Energy, Environment & Installations



<u>"Asks"</u>

- Base HQ U.S. Space Command or component parts in San Antonio
- Base 16th Air Force's information warfare missions in San Antonio
- Consider San Antonio first for new USAF missions (example: Special Warfare Wing)

<u>Take-aways</u>

- San Antonio faring well in evaluation process
- Next Defense Community Infrastructure Program (DCIP) process should include significantly more funding than the first round

- Consider "Community Partnership" education program to align HS/college programs with military hiring needs
- Working with Joint Base San Antonio to submit a DCIP project
- Continue to monitor USAF Space Command announcements
- SAEDF researching DoD's community partnership program for applicability in SA Works program





General Daniel R. Hokanson Chief, National Guard Bureau (NGB)



<u>"Asks"</u>

- Consider additional National Guard missions at Martindale Army Air Field/San Antonio
- Thanked NGB for decision to designate a State Partnership Program (SPP) between the 149th Fighter Wing and the Egyptian Air Force
- Consider San Antonio for additional F-16 basing

Take-aways

Action Items

 OMVA follow-up with Texas National Guard regarding ground units being based at Martindale Army Air Field -- and provide support, as appropriate





General Charles Q. Brown Chief of Staff, United States Air Force Mr. Shon Monasco, Assistant Secretary of the Air Force Wayne Peacock/President & CEO USAA (call in)



<u>"Asks"</u>

- Choose San Antonio as the site for HQ U.S. Space Command
- San Antonio to be the first choice to base 16th Air Force's information warfare missions
- Hold USAF's 75th anniversary celebration in San Antonio (2022)
- Hold DoD Warrior Games in San Antonio (2022 and 2024)

Take-aways

- Gen Brown impressed with San Antonio workforce efforts
- Gen Brown commended USAA and business community for support of Airmen and military families

- Continue to monitor HQ Space Command announcements
- Formal invitation to General Brown for next Fiesta event







CURRENT STATUS



- SECDES Program part of the City's State Legislative Agenda
 - ✓ Working with state House/Senate representatives to craft language in the law
 - ✓ Law will facilitate collection of medical costs to the military & ease financial burden on patients
- Advocacy to grow DHA footprint continues
 - ✓ In December, additional DHA staff were transferred to Ft. Sam Houston (~220/Physical Disabilities Agency-{700})
- Continued monitoring for additional missions, to include USSPACECOM or USSF units
 - **USSPACECOM** and USSF have new units on the horizon
- Warrior Games Met with Pentagon and City officials to finalize 2022 Warrior Games in San Antonio
 ✓ On track
- Working with JBSA to identify potential DCIP projects
- National Guard ground unit movement to Martindale Army Airfield and rotary wing assets to Lackland AFB

 On track
- USSPACECOM survey taking place Saturday, 12 December 2020
 - ✓ 4-star General: "Mayor's visit to the Pentagon moved the needle" & "Only city visit I have been asked to host"
