# AN ORDINANCE 2020-09-17-0646

### ORDINANCE CARRYING FORWARD CERTAIN FY 2020 FUNDS; AMENDING PRIOR APPROPRIATIONS; APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR REQUIREMENTS IN CITY PROJECTS AND DEPARTMENTS; RATIFYING CERTAIN GRANTS, EMERGENCY CONTRACTS AND PURCHASES AS A RESULT OF THE IMPACTS OF COVID-19 ON THE COMMUNITY; APPROVING CERTAIN CONTRACTS; AND APPROPRIATING OTHER FUNDS

WHEREAS, through Ordinance No. 2019-09-12-0692, passed and approved September 12, 2019 the City Council adopted the annual operating and capital budget for the City of San Antonio for Fiscal Year 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department provided guidance to and workshops for City Departments on the Fiscal Year 2020 year-end close-out procedures, including assistance in understanding and determining which encumbered balances should be carried forward to Fiscal Year 2021 and which should be cancelled; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to carry forward certain appropriations including unencumbered funds listed in Attachment I from the current Fiscal Year, close accounting records for certain funds; and make appropriations for certain funds; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends that the Federal Grants and associated personnel in Attachment II related to the COVID-19 Response, Recovery & Resiliency plan be ratified and accepted; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends that the actions set forth in Attachment III of this Ordinance be taken in the General Fund and certain Restricted Funds to allow for the approval and ratification of certain emergency purchases; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is part of the City's annual year-end fiscal close-out process; and

WHEREAS the City must comply with requirements of the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) as established by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB); and

WHEREAS, the actions authorized by this Ordinance do not increase budgeted expenditures within the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget, and such actions are necessary to ensure execution of Fiscal Year 2020 commitments; NOW THEREFORE;

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1. Carry Forward Prior Year Appropriations.** That the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget (adopted by Ordinance No. 2020-09-17-0641 dated September 17, 2020) for all funds is hereby increased by the Fiscal Year 2020 ending balance amounts listed in **Attachment I** in the designated accounts, which are hereby appropriated from the unappropriated fund balance of designated funds. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer is hereby directed to carry forward the actual available

ending balance for Fiscal Year 2020 of the accounts listed in **Attachment I**. The actual available ending balance may be lower or higher than the amounts listed in **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. Acceptance of COVID-19 related grant awards from the Federal and State Governments. The grants shown in Attachment II are hereby accepted as awarded and a total of three positions are authorized in the COVID-19 Response Activities and Laboratory Response Network grant to support the program. The City Manager or his designee are authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to achieve the acceptance of such grants. Any and all actions formally taken in connection with the application for and/or acceptance of such grants are hereby ratified and confirmed in all things

Furthermore, this Ordinance authorizes the City Manager or his designee(s) to initiate, negotiate, and execute any and all necessary documents and a grant contract to effectuate the acceptance of such grants, and to execute contract amendments pertaining to the contract(s) related to such grants.

**SECTION 3. Ratification of Contracts and Purchases related to COVID-19.** Contracts and purchases in an amount not to exceed \$18,605,373 as shown in **Attachment III**, for items such as contact tracing, testing, financial counseling, personal protective equipment (PPE), contactless ticketing entry gate turnstiles, touchless faucets & toilet retrofits, ultra violet disinfection robots, electronic appointment scheduling system and other equipment, are hereby ratified and confirmed. All other actions of the City Manager or his designee(s) related to expenditures, amendments, modifications and suspensions of contracts undertaken between March 19, 2020 and September 30, 2020 as part of the City's COVID-19 response management are hereby ratified and confirmed in all things.

**SECTION 4. Carry Forward Prior Years' Encumbrances.** That the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget is hereby amended by the amount of Fiscal Year 2020 outstanding encumbrances and earmarks as approved by the Budget Director by the closeout of the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget. In the event any Fiscal Year 2020 outstanding encumbrances or earmarks carried forward into Fiscal Year 2021 are deemed to be unnecessary, then said encumbrances and earmarks are hereby authorized to be canceled and any corresponding appropriations reduced and returned to fund balance. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer is hereby directed to carry forward the actual available ending balance for Fiscal Year 2020 of the encumbrances and earmarks approved by the Budget Director.

**SECTION 5**. **Close Out Trust & Agency Funds Projects.** That any completed projects in Trust and Agency funds identified through the year-end close-out process are hereby authorized to be closed, and any remaining funds are authorized to be appropriated for transfer, if allowable under Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP), to the appropriate fund(s), including, but not limited to, the General Fund. Any deficit balances can be funded with available surplus funds in applicable operating funds as identified and approved by the Budget Director and Deputy Chief Financial Officer, unless such funding is inconsistent with other legal or accounting requirements.

**SECTION 6.** Close Out Capital Projects & Grant Projects. That upon completion of each capital project and grant project identified through the year-end close-out process, such capital projects and grant projects are hereby authorized to be closed and unencumbered balances or

unspent appropriated balances of those projects are hereby authorized to be released in the originating fund. Any remaining cash balances are authorized to be transferred to the General Fund, unless such transfer is inconsistent with other legal or accounting requirements. Any deficit balances can be funded with available surplus balances as identified and approved by the Budget Director and Deputy Chief Financial Officer, unless such transfer is inconsistent with other legal or accounting requirements.

**SECTION 7.** Close Out Restricted Funds. That upon completion of reconciliation of restricted funds as part of the Fiscal Year 2020 close-out process, remaining positive balances are authorized to be used to offset negative balances, unless such use is inconsistent with other legal or accounting requirements. Any remaining cash balances are authorized to be transferred to the General Fund, unless such transfer is inconsistent with other legal or accounting requirements.

**SECTION 8. General Accounting Standards Board (GASB) Statements Implementation.** That the Deputy Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to take any and all necessary actions to implement each GASB Statement that is effective for and applicable to Fiscal Year 2020.

**SECTION 9.** Accounting Adjustments. That the Deputy Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to make any and all necessary accounting adjustments to comply with ordinances approved during Fiscal Year 2020, to analyze and report receivables based on collectability, and to write-off specifically identified U.S. Housing and Urban Development grant loan receivables whose funding purpose has been fully satisfied but whose loans are in default and deemed uncollectable due to bankruptcy, foreclosure or death.

**SECTION 10. Budget Ordinance Adjustments.** That the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget is hereby amended to conform with re-estimates included in the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget. Budget adjustments are authorized between funds to reflect actual debt payments and other transfers originally authorized in the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget and as re-estimated in the proposed Fiscal Year 2021 Budget.

- A. That the 2020-2024 Five-Year Infrastructure Management Plan (IMP) approved September 12, 2019 by Ordinance 2019-09-12-0692 is hereby amended regarding the list of street projects and concurrence memos included as Attachment IV.
- B. Funds in the amount of \$145,000 are authorized to be transferred from the FY 2020 City Council District 3 Budget, GL 6102100, IO 39000000000, Cost Center 103010001 Fund 11001000 and appropriated in the COVID Emergency Affordable Housing Fund GL 6101100, Internal Order 311000000000 Fund 29623003 to provide assistance to approximately 50 households within District 3.
- C. Any and all necessary adjustments to be made to the FY 2020 General Fund Budget as amended on June 4, 2020 to address COVID-19 expenditures and transfers in line with the revised COVID-19 Response, Recovery & Resiliency plan are hereby authorized, ratified and confirmed in all things, and any such adjustments may be carried forward into the FY 2021 Operating and Capital Budget.

- D. That certain contract with the National Mexican American Civil Rights Institute ("Institute Contract") that provides for the establishment of a Mexican American Civil Rights Institute in San Antonio ("Institute"), with a term beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020, in the amount of \$250,000 consistent with the appropriations set forth in the FY 2020 Adopted Budget and designated for the Institute, is hereby authorized, ratified and confirmed in all things. A copy of the Institute Contract is attached as Attachment V.
- E. That certain in-kind grant from the Southwest Texas Regional Advisory Council for FY 2020 and 2021 STRAC EMS County 911 grants, in the amount not to exceed \$107,692.00, is hereby authorized, ratified and confirmed in all things. Any and all actions formally taken in connection with the application for and/or acceptance of such grants are hereby ratified and confirmed in all things.

**SECTION 11. Temporary Fund Transfers.** That the Deputy Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to temporarily transfer funds to various Funds with negative cash balances at the end of Fiscal Year 2020 from the General Fund ending cash balance, and/or cash balances from other City Funds if necessary, for financial statement presentation and for compliance with GAAP, provided that said transfer(s) shall be reversed within ten (10) working days.

**SECTION 12. Budget Ordinances Amendments.** That the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2019-09-12-0692, passed and approved September 12, 2019, and the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2020-09-17-xxxx passed and approved September 17, 2020, is each hereby amended in accordance with the provisions set forth above.

**SECTION 13. Effective Date.** Except as otherwise provided for herein, this Ordinance is effective immediately, upon passage by eight (8) affirmative votes; otherwise said effective date shall be ten (10) days from the date of passage hereof.

Transportation and Capital Improvements Department (TCI) has two street rehabilitation projects funded through the FY 2019 IMP that need to be reprogrammed.

The Public Works Department (PWD) has Microsurface street preservation projects on Bluffside Dr., Eaglerock Dr., Evandale Dr., Ferncroft Dr., and Chadwick Dr. scheduled in the FY 2020 Infrastructure Management Program (IMP). Minor base and pavement repairs were conducted on these streets, and after further evaluation, staff has determined that an Onyx Seal is a more appropriate application for these streets. Therefore, staff recommends revising the initial application for these projects to an Onyx Seal application. Additional funds will be made available due to this revision which will allow for the completion of other projects. The Public Works Department (PWD) has a street preservation project on Van Ness Drive and Camino Rosa scheduled in the FY 2020 Infrastructure Management Program (IMP). Staff recently conducted site visits for these two streets and determined that the condition of the pavement has degraded significantly since these projects were originally included in the FY 2020 IMP. Consequently, staff recommends upgrading the application for these streets to rehabilitation projects, which costs significantly more than the allocated budget. As a result of funding constraints in the current fiscal year, staff recommends deferring these projects to FY 2025 and accelerating/adding projects featured in the table below to fill the resulting gap in the FY 2020 IMP budget. The details of these projects are shown below. Since these changes impact the IMP that was adopted as part of the FY 2020 budget, your concurrence is needed to finalize this action.

Transportation and Capital Improvements Department (TCI) has a street preservation project on Bluewood Street scheduled in the FY 2020 IMP. Staff determined that this street was inadvertently programmed for preservation through the FY 2019 & FY 2020 IMP programs. Consequently, staff recommends the removal of the FY 2020 Fog Seal project scheduled for this street and the reprogramming of the allocated funds. In coordination with the Council Office, staff is recommending the utilization of these available funds by accelerating the project on Ronald Drive. Since these changes impact the IMP adopted as part of the FY 2020 budget, your concurrence will complete this action.
