



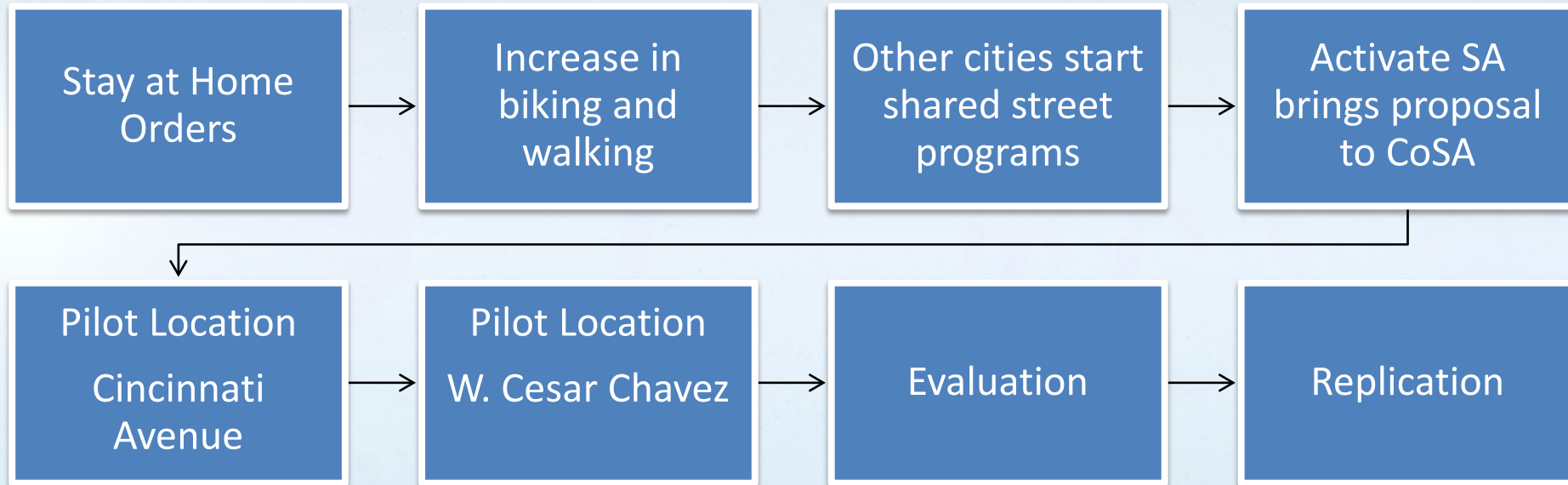

- Connects destinations like parks and schools
- Recommend low traffic, low speed



- Schematic developed
- VIA Coordination
- Barricade and signage placement
- Flyer notification to residents and businesses
- Adjustments as needed
- 30-day pilot





- Type 3 Barricades
- Temporarily lowered speed guidance with custom signs





- Speed trailer
- Additional barricades as needed



- Council Districts, neighborhoods, and on Next Door
- 40 response over 4 weeks
- Flyers dropped off at residences

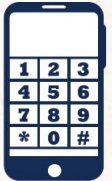
