



- Schematic developed
- VIA Coordination
- Barricade and signage placement
- Flyer notification to residents and businesses
- Adjustments as needed
- 30-day pilot

- Type 3 Barricades
- Temporarily lowered speed guidance with custom signs








SAN ANTONIO
