Background

- DHS contracts with STRAC to provide mental health clinician services to SAPD Chronic Crisis Stabilization Initiative (CCSI)
- FY 21 budget includes \$297,299 for CCSI

 Amendment adds \$150,000 to support a systems assessment by Meadows Mental Health Policy Institute (MMPI)



Southwest Texas Regional Advisory Council

- Designated by the State to develop, implement, maintain regional trauma and emergency healthcare system
- STRAC established the Southwest Texas Crisis Collaborative (STCC) :
- Data management, program oversight, contract/grant management and administration of SDOH/Signify Community
- Coordinates with MMPI to identify statewide best practices in mental health crisis management

Interlocal Amendment will:



Support MMPI-led systems assessment to identify improvements to existing mental health crisis first response system

Ensure first responders have support to ensure safety/security of individual and community in mental health crisis

Develop strategy and work plan to implement improvements for mental health crisis first response system

 Authorization of an amendment to an Interlocal Agreement with STRAC in the amount of \$150,000 from GF to support a mental health systems assessment conducted by the Meadows Mental Health Policy Institute
