2. An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:

The Solid Waste Management Department is required by State Statute to collect refuse weekly for the health and safety of the community. Operational demands require reliable operational requirements that have been found in the Autocar ACX64 chassis and the Heil Durapak Python Body. 31 automated side load refuse trucks are scheduled to be replaced in FY 2021 with the addition of 4 refuse trucks to the fleet of the same build; for a total of 35 refuse trucks to be obtained in FY 2021. 33 refuse trucks will come equipped with the standard automated side load arm. 2 refuse trucks will come equipped with a Command SST arm. These trucks are available through Sourcewell #081716-ATC and HGAC# HT06-20 cooperative contracts currently in place, however the local dealer (Grande Truck Center) should be given an opportunity to bid as part of a request for offers.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with Grande Truck Center which will cost approximately \$ 13,121,550.81
