ORDINANCE

AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO BY AMENDING CHAPTER 35, UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE, SECTION 35-304, OF THE CITY CODE OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS BY CHANGING THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARY OF CERTAIN PROPERTY.

## WHEREAS, a public hearing was held after notice and publication regarding this amendment to

 the Official Zoning Map at which time parties in interest and citizens were given an opportunity to be heard; andWHEREAS, the Zoning Commission has submitted a final report to the City Council regarding this amendment to the Official Zoning Map of the City of San Antonio; NOW THEREFORE,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Chapter 35, Unified Development Code, Section 35-304, Official Zoning Map, of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is amended by changing the zoning district boundary of 9.117 acres out of NCB 18333 from "RM-6 MSAO-1 MLR-1" Residential Mixed Camp Bullis Military Sound Attenuation Camp Bullis Military Lighting Overlay Military Lighting Region 1 District to "PUD R-4 MSAO-1 MLOD-1 MLR-1" Planned Unit Development Residential Single-Family Camp Bullis Military Sound Attenuation Camp Bullis Lighting Overlay Military Lighting Region 1 District (with reduced perimeter setback of 10 ').

SECTION 2. A description of the property is attached as Exhibit " $\mathbf{A}$ " and made a part hereof and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 3. The City council approves this Planned Unit Development so long as the attached site plan is adhered to. A site plan is attached as Exhibit "B" and made a part hereof and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 4. All other provisions of Chapter 35 except those expressly amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect including the penalties for violations as made and provided for in Section 35-491.

SECTION 5. The Director of Development Services shall change the zoning records and maps in accordance with this ordinance and the same shall be available and open to the public for inspection.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall become effective January 31, 2021.

4. $\mathrm{N} \mathbf{1 0 ^ { \circ }} \mathbf{3} 5^{\prime} \mathbf{3 8} 8^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of $\mathbf{2 8 1 . 1 5}$ feet to a point, for an exterior corner of the tract described herein,
$5^{\circ} \mathrm{N} 12^{\circ} \mathbf{3} 6^{\prime} 13^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, a distance of $\mathbf{1 1 3 . 3 7}$ feet to a point, for an exterior corner of the tract described herein, and
5. $\mathbf{N} \mathbf{8 2}{ }^{\circ} 41^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, a distance of $\mathbf{3 9 2 . 0 0}$ feet to a point in the southwest right-of-way line of Luskey Blvd. and the northeast line of Lot 3, for the northeast corner of the tract described herein, from which a found $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ iron rod in the common line of Luskey Blvd. and Lot 3 bears, N $33^{\circ} 14^{\prime} 05^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of 98.00 feet;

THENCE: Along and with the common line between Luskey Blvd. and Lot 3, the following three (3) courses:

1. With a curve to the left, having an arc length of $\mathbf{4 3 7 . 9 1}$ feet, a radius of $\mathbf{8 8 7 . 0 0}$ feet, a delta of $28^{\circ} 17^{\prime} 13^{\prime \prime}$, and a chord bears $S 50^{\circ} 32^{\prime} 42^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, a distance of 433.48 feet to a found $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ iron rod, for a point of reverse curvature of the tract described herein,
2. With a curve to the right, having an arc length of $\mathbf{2 9 8 . 3 9}$ feet, a radius of 413.00 feet, a delta of $41^{\circ} 23^{\prime} 43^{\prime \prime}$, and a chord bears $\mathbf{S} 43^{\circ} 59^{\prime} 27^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{E}$, a distance of 291.94 feet to a found $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ iron rod, for a point of reverse curvature of the tract described herein, and
3. With a curve to the left, having an arc length of $\mathbf{1 3 9 . 2 2}$ feet, a radius of $\mathbf{4 8 7 . 0 0}$ feet, a delta of $16^{\circ} 22^{\prime} 46^{\prime \prime}$, and a chord bears $S \mathbf{3 1} 1^{\circ} 28^{\prime} 58^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{E}$, a distance of $\mathbf{1 3 8 . 7 5}$ feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 9.117 acres, or 397,147 square feet, more or less, in Bexar County, Texas. Bearings are based on NAD83 Texas State Plane South Central Zone.
