ORDINANCE

**AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO E-Z BEL
CONSTRUCTION, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$1,940,478.83 FOR THE SOUTH ZARZAMORA STREET/APPLEWHITE
ROAD INTERSECTION PROJECT.**

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WHEREAS, in May 2017 voters approved the 2017 Bond Program which authorized \$900,000.00 for the South Zarzamora Street/Applewhite Road Intersection project located in Council District 4; and

WHEREAS, as part of the FY 2020 adopted budget, funds in the additional amount of \$1,750,000.00 were approved for this project; and

WHEREAS, this project will provide for the demolition and reconstruction of the existing intersection to reconfigure South Zarzamora Street and Applewhite Road intersection by removing the traffic signal and creating two T-intersections; and

WHEREAS, this project was advertised for construction bids on August 12, 2020, and three (3) bids were received and opened on September 15, 2020, of which one was deemed not responsible; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by E-Z Bel Construction, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$1,940,478.83 for the South Zarzamora Street/Applewhite Road Intersection project; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid by E-Z Bel Construction, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$1,940,478.83 for the South Zarzamora Street/Applewhite Road Intersection project, is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates.

SECTION 2. Payment is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to E-Z Bel Construction, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$1,940,478.83. Payment is in support of the S Zarzamora St/Applewhite Rd Intersection Project using Fund 45099000, with the WBS 23-01611-05-02-01 and GL 5201140. Funding for this project is provided by GO Bonds and is in the FY2021-FY2026 CIP Budget.

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Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with approved operating and/or capital budgets for current and future fiscal years.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
