The offer submitted by HUB Parking Technology USA, Inc., to provide nine ZEAG Parking Revenue Control Systems cash handling stations for the San Antonio Aviation Department, Parking Division, for a total cost of \$71,067.42 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.
