Ananda Tomas stated that the Collective Bargaining Agreement would never be equitable due to the Evergreen Clause.

James Dykman stated that the City Council failed to pass a non-binding Resolution regarding the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

Vincent Rydzak stated that SAWS changed the valve on his water meter without notifying him and he did not have the tools necessary to turn his water off.

Anna Vuich stated that certain rules in the Collective Bargaining Agreement allowed for injustice. She noted that arbitration that was subjective and allowed Officers to be given the benefit of the doubt.

Justice Martinez urged the City Council to repeal Chapters 143 and 174 of the Texas Local Government Code.

Desiree Schanding stated that arbitration should never be used to keep bad Officers.
