

### PRIORITY BILLS

#### **Early Matters Priority Bills:**

- Mandatory TRS, contracting, and Pre-K partnership reporting: SB 2087/HB 2607 (Lucio/Talarico/Button) Passed out of committee
- Workforce: HB 619 (S. Thompson) Passed out of committee
- Cost of quality: HB 1964 (Lopez) No vote
- Reimbursement Rates: SB 1555/HB 1695 (Zaffirini/Raney) Passed out of committee
- Centralizing TRS: **SB 694/HB 1792** (Zaffirini/Button) **Passed out of committee**
- . Child care contracts: SB 971/HB 1364 (Zaffirini/Romero) Passed out of committee

#### **Texas House Early Childhood Caucus**

- Launched this session
- Co-chairs: Diego Bernal, Angie Button (Houston)
