Issue Proposed for Consideration

I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda of the earliest available meeting of the City Council:

Concurrence in the support, intention and direction of the San Antonio Police Department to assess the feasibility and budget impact & revenue loss of the elimination of the fee associated with the return of personal property of those arrested and/or detained.

Brief Background

The elimination of property repossession fees allows the arrestee all available resources in their attempts to reconcile the alleged violation by having identification documents, currency and any other items that also allows for the return to work and other societal duties;

This CCR is intended to serve as the conduit to the assessment of the before mentioned fee removal and will allow persons charged with offenses to return to their daily duties and responsibilities that keep them productive members of our community within expected measures of assured security and safety to the broader community.
