



# Police Service Review Community Meetings

The results of the scientific survey will serve as the foundation for virtual community town hall meetings, which seek to gather feedback on community's expectations of interactions with SAPD and alternative response to certain 911 calls. Data and information gathered from this process will be used to inform the development of recommendations to the Public Safety Committee and ultimately the City Council.

## Virtual Community Meetings

The City of San Antonio will host virtual district specific input meetings throughout April and May in collaboration with each of the City's ten council districts. The goal of this meetings is to gather feedback on community's expectations of interactions with SAPD and alternative response to certain 911 calls.

In addition to the virtual community meetings, the City will also host a series of city-wide virtual community discussions, telephone town hall meetings, a dedicated event for Spanish speakers and a series of meetings with local stakeholder groups.
