Health & Safety Environment Screener Status & Process

As required by Head Start Performance Standards, within the first 45 days of the program start date the Early Head Start (EHS) program conducts Health and Safety Environment Screenings for each for the one inner city childcare facilities. Due to COVID-19 and the delay in opening the new EHS facility, the first day for children for in-person services was March 29, 2021.

The EHS Monitor uses a 58-Point checklist to assess compliance in the following core areas: Classrooms Safety, Safety Procedures & Observations, Facility Layout and Environment, Medical Administration, Outdoors, and Transportation.
