## **ORDINANCE**

APPROVING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL **OF** \$1,557,606.00, **INCLUDED** IN THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENT'S FY 2021 ADOPTED BUDGET: (A) SAN ANTONIO LIGHTHOUSE FOR THE BLIND AND NESTLE WATERS NORTH AMERICA, INC., FOR BOTTLED WATER SERVICES; (B) HEARST CORP, DBA SAN ANTONIO EXPRESS-NEWS, AND SA LEGAL NEWS, LLC, DBA THE HART BEAT, FOR OFFICIAL AND OTHER CONSOLIDATED **NEWSPAPER** ADVERTISING; (C) **TRAFFIC** CONTROLS, INC., FOR STEEL TRAFFIC SIGNAL POLES; AND (D) KONICA MINOLTA BUSINESS SOLUTIONS U.S.A., INC., FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE ANNUAL CONTRACT FOR A PRINT MANAGEMENT SOLUTION FOR THE SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC LIBRARY.

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WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the alternate bids submitted by Nestle Waters North America, Inc., for items 4 and 6, failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for bottled water services; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted by Hill Country Electric Supply and Wildcat Electric Supply failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for steel traffic signal poles; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves contracts with (A) San Antonio Lighthouse for the Blind and Nestle Waters North America, Inc., for bottled water services; (B) Hearst Corp, dba San Antonio Express-News, and SA Legal News, LLC, dba The Hart Beat, for official and other newspaper advertising; (C) Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc., for steel traffic signal poles; and (D) an amendment to the Konica Minolta Business Solutions U.S.A., Inc., annual contract for a print management solution for the San Antonio Public Library; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Konica Minolta Business Solutions U.S.A., Inc., for a print management solution for the San Antonio Public Library meets the requirements under the terms of the TexBuy Interlocal Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance No. 2015-06-18-0525; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

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**SECTION 1.** The following bids to furnish the City with goods and services on an annual basis as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements: (A) San Antonio Lighthouse for the Blind and Nestle Waters North America, Inc., for bottled water services; (B) Hearst Corp, dba San Antonio Express-News, and SA Legal News, LLC, dba The Hart Beat, for official and other newspaper advertising; (C) Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc., for steel traffic signal poles; and (D) an amendment to the Konica Minolta Business Solutions U.S.A., Inc., annual contract for a print management solution for the San Antonio Public Library. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

**SECTION 2.** It has been found and declared that the alternate bids submitted by Nestle Waters North America, Inc., for items 4 and 6, failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for bottled water services.

**SECTION 3.** It has been found and declared that the bids submitted by Hill Country Electric Supply and Wildcat Electric Supply failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for steel traffic signal poles.

**SECTION 4.** Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2021 budget, and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contracts through their terms as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
