**WHEREAS,** Ordinance No. 2018-10-11-0809 authorized a Job Order Contract with Alpha Building Corporation to provide construction, renovation and maintenance services to the facilities in the airport system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Aviation Department wishes to construct a family restroom/adult changing station in Terminal B of the San Antonio International Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance approves a Task Order in the amount not to exceed \$109,991.54 for this work: **NOW THEREFORE**,

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** City staff is authorized to proceed and approve a Task Order to the Job Order Contract with Alpha Building Corporation in the not to exceed amount of \$109,991.54 for the family restroom/adult changing station in Terminal B of the San Antonio International Airport.

**SECTION 2.** Payment is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to Alpha Building Corporation in an amount not to exceed \$109,991.54. Payment is in support of the Terminal B Expansion Project, using Fund 51099000, with the WBS Element 33-00295-05-03 and GL Account 5201140. Funding is provided by Airport Financing and is in the FY2020-FY2025 Aviation CIP Budget.

Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with approved operating and/or capital budgets for current and future fiscal years.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

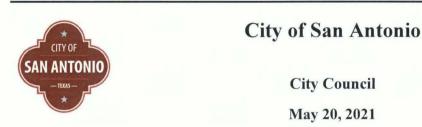
