Regarding: Claude Black Community Center – site improvements and building waterproofing

Good morning Mr. Griego,

Tejas Premier is pleased to submit our proposal for Claude Black Community Center – site improvements and building waterproofing. Our proposal includes the following scope of work:

Brick / Mortar

- 1. Identify areas where mortar is open 1/16" or larger and tuck point using mortar/sealants.
- 2. Replace Brick if missing.
- 3. Power wash and install sealer Master Protect H440VT silane sealer.

Window caulking and other sealants

- 1. Remove all old sealants using mechanical means if needed.
- 2. Install primer and backer rod as specified by manufacture.
- 3. All exterior walls will receive BASF NP 1/2 sealant or Sika 1A/2C urethane sealant (whichever is available).
- 4. All window perimeters will receive Sika 1A/2C urethane sealant.
- 5. All glass will receive Dow silicone tooled according to manufactures specifications.

Site Work Improvement

- 1. All site work as per civil construction document sheets 1 to 5 dated 10-22-2020.
- 2. Selective demo existing lower slab, upper slab, stairs, ramp and retaining wall.
- 3. Haul off all concrete spoils and grade for new concrete slab,
- 4. Place forms and rebar, for slab, retaining wall and flume.
- 5. Fabricate and install new handrails.
- 6. Sawcut joints for new concrete.
- 7. New sod to replace any damaged due to work performed.

Assumptions and Clarifications:

- Excludes painting any surface metal, wood, masonry, caulking upper windows with wood shade on gym portion (shade assembly is to close).
- 2. Tuck point brick repair- this is not a complete mortar replacement. This will address areas where mortar is cracked and or a brick is missing. Contractor may determine caulking would work for separation and movement more efficiently than mortar.
- 3. All work will be done during normal business hours, Monday Friday. Access to the work area will be allowed starting at 8:00am to 5:00pm
- 4. Excludes permitting fees.
- 5. This project has no liquidated damages.
- The project will begin after the Purchase Order Number is issued and the bid is valid for 30 days.
- 7. Sales tax excluded from this bid.
