2. Trees planted include all the trees planted by City staff, contractors, or partner organizations on both public and private property. Some of these programs include planting of trees in City parks / facilities.


FY 2021 Under 1 Roof Program


FY 2020 Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation & Reconstruction Program
