ORDINANCE

APPROVING A TASK ORDER TO A JOB ORDER CONTRACT TO CON-COR INC. FOR THE OLMOS BASIN PARK WATER AND SEWER LINE SERVICE FOR EXISTING STRUCTURES LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICTS 1 AND 2 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000.00. FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE AND ARE INCLUDED IN THE FY 2021 - 2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

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WHEREAS, Olmos Basin Park is located at 851 Devine and was deeded to the City in 1925 with many of the improvements happened in the park with the Civilian Conservation Core (CCC) in the mid-1930s; and

WHEREAS, subsequently, the water and sewer lines that service the park buildings and restrooms were established in the 1940s and only minor maintenance and repairs have been done to date over the last 70 years; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2019-02-21-0134 authorized a Job Order Contract (JOC) with Con-Cor, Inc. to provide on-call construction, renovation and maintenance services for City buildings and facilities, and

WHEREAS, this is task order will provide for the replacement of the main water and sewer lines in the park to service the restroom buildings, water fountains, and leased facilities including the San Antonio Gun Club and will not impact the tree canopy as the boring method will be utilized; and

WHEREAS, construction is anticipated to begin in July and be completed by end of September 2021; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance authorizes a task order to a Job Order Contract for the Olmos Basin Park water and sewer line replacement in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 to Con-Cor Inc.; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department or designee, is authorized to execute a Job Order Contract with Con-Cor Inc. for Olmos Basin Park water and sewer line service for existing structures located in Council Districts 1 and 2 in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00.

SECTION 2. NO FINANCIALS AVAILABLE.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
