- Accepting \$35.5M in CARES & CRRSA grants
- Authorizing/Extending agreements for:
  - Homeless low barrier-emergency shelter
  - Clinical and epidemiology support
  - COVID-19 surveillance/data analysis
  - Emergency rental assistance with Bexar County

#### American Rescue Plan Act 2021 (ARPA)

#### • Accepting \$302.1M in ARPA grants

- Authorizing/Extending contracts:
  - University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston – Case investigations/contact tracing
  - University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio Dr. Barbara Taylor
  - Referral to community health worker hub
  - School-based mental health
  - Domestic Violence Counseling
  - Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System

- 49 Rooms

 Contract with SAMMinistries to operate low-barrier shelter -\$1.73 million



## **Use of Fiscal Recovery Funds Strategy**





 \$49.7 Million ARPA Emergency Rental Assistance Award recommended to be appropriated to continue current program

 Current EHAP budget: \$133.6 Million
 Assisted 36,000 Households with Rental, Mortgage, and Utility Assistance
 Expect to Utilize Funds by July
