Health & Safety Screener Status and Process

As required by Head Start Performance Standards, within the first 75 calendar days of the program year the Head Start program conducts a Healthy and Safety Screening for each of the 22 Head Start locations. The Head Start Monitoring Team uses 80-Point checklist to assess compliance in the following core areas: Facilities, Medication Administration, Outdoor Review, Safe Environments, Safety Practices, and Transportation. In addition, the Head Start program utilizes the Office of Head Start Health and Safety Screener Tool as guidance to include reviewing Human Resources and Staff Training requirements.
