As required by Head Start Performance Standards, within the first 45 days of the program year the Early Head Start (EHS) program conducts Health and Safety Environment Screenings for each for the one inner city childcare facilities. The EHS Monitor uses a 58-Point checklist to assess compliance in the following core areas: Classrooms Safety, Safety Procedures & Observations, Facility Layout and Environment, Medical Administration, Outdoors, and Transportation.
