Item 1 was addressed at this time.

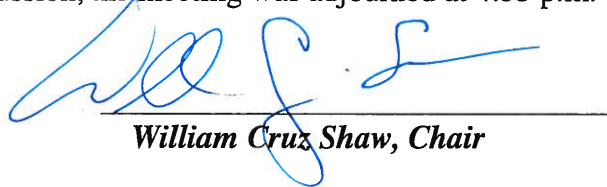
1. Approval of the Minutes from the Municipal Court Advisory Committee Meeting of May 9, 2018.

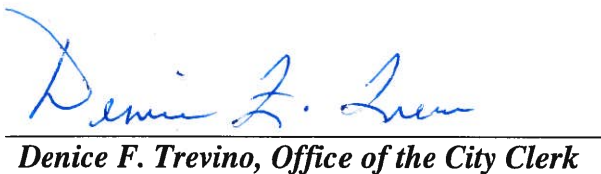
Adjourn
