Stephen Versteeg stated that there appeared to be a compromise in the Z-4 zoning case. He added that neighbors were not opposed to development, but were trying to drive for development that would fit and enhance the neighborhood. He thanked the neighbors and everyone who was listening for their attentiveness.

Jesus Mendoza stated that he had been homebound for more than 9 years with life threatening electrosensitivity (ESS) which was caused and aggravated by micro-radiation. He expressed concern for students and the general public who could be exposed to micro-radiation.
