Henry Rodriguez, Maria Lopez and Ignacio Lopez of LULAC Zapatista thanked outgoing Councilmembers for their service. They stated that a press conference would be held tomorrow in front of the Alamo at 11:00 AM to ask that sacred grounds at the Alamo be respected. They spoke of Rosa Lopez, previous Riverwalk vendor, and stated that her business should be grandfathered as a Riverwalk vendor.

Jose Sierra stated that the City sat on a number of Spanish/Mexican land grants. He noted that the Black Lives Matter group needed to get in line behind descendants of individuals affected by the 1941 Mexican-American Treaty.
