### SUBJECT:

Indigenous People's Day

### SUMMARY:

This item will recognize October 12<sup>th</sup> as Indigenous People's Day.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

At the October 8, 2015 City Council meeting, Councilmember Ray Saldana stated he supported a Resolution to recognize October 12<sup>th</sup> as Indigenous People's Day in San Antonio. Mayor Ivy Taylor, Councilmember Allan Warrick, and Councilmember Roberto C. Trevino also voiced their support of this Resolution.

Bexar County has recognized October 12<sup>th</sup> as Indigenous People's Day in Bexar County.

### ISSUE:

Resolutions require a vote by City Council.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

City Council could chose to not recognize October 12<sup>th</sup> as Indigenous People's Day or could choose another date as Indigenous People's Day.
