On October 27, 2015 the Housing Commission established three subcommittees that will meet monthly as needed. - Recommendations assigned to the Resident Retention Subcommittee

The Housing Bond and Funding Subcommittee consists of a Committee of the Whole with Jennifer Gonzalez as Chair and Gil Piette as Vice Chair.

The Policy and Infrastructure Subcommittee includes seven (7) members from the Housing Commission: Jennifer Gonzalez - Chair, Jim Bailey - Vice Chair, Carol Rodriguez, Noah Garcia, Natalie Griffith, Rod Radle, and Mu Son Chi.

The Resident Retention Subcommittee includes six (6) members from the Housing Commission: Jennifer Gonzalez - Chair, Natalie Griffith - Vice Chair, Jackie Gorman, Jim Bailey, Carol Rodriguez, and Richard Milk.
