SUMMARY:

On October 27, 2015 the Housing Commission to Protect and Preserve Dynamic and Diverse Neighborhoods established the Housing Bond and Funding Subcommittee in order to discuss relevant items on the Commission's FY 2016 Work Plan and to develop recommendations to bring back to the Commission for possible action. The name of the Subcommittee has also changed to Housing Funding Subcommittee to avoid confusion with the Community Bond Committees that have been established in relation to the proposed 2017-2022 Bond Program. ISSUE:

A draft version of the Housing Commission's FY 2017 Work Plan was presented to the Commission on September 27, 2016. The Housing Funding Subcommittee will discuss relevant items from the Draft Work Plan, including the Identification of Ongoing Sources of Funds for the Creation and Preservation of Affordable/Workforce Housing. The Subcommittee will identify data needs as well as prioritize staff briefings on best practices from peer cities.
