The City of San Antonio is issuing this Request for Qualifications in an effort to obtain qualified, professional service-related Construction Inspection Services. All firms proposing to provide inspection services for City will be expected to have an established staff capable of providing the in-house services for City's Architectural and/or Engineering projects for the duration of a project's construction phase on an as-needed basis. The construction inspectors will work as part of City's construction administration team and will be asked to be a representative of City. The construction inspectors will provide skilled construction quality assurance, to ensure compliance with contract documents, as well as assisting and reporting to City's Project Manager during a project's construction phase.
