SUBJECT:

Settlement of a lawsuit styled Norma Rodriguez v. City of San Antonio

SUMMARY:

This item authorizes the settlement of a lawsuit styled *Norma Rodriguez v. City of San Antonio*; Cause Number 2016-CI-11334, pending in 285th Judicial District Court, Bexar County, Texas in the amount of \$80,000.00 paid from the Self-Insurance Liability Fund.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Norma Rodriguez Cynthia Harris (corrected August 29, 2018) is seeking damages as a result of an auto accident that occurred on August 11, 2014 at the intersection of South Zarzamora Street and New Laredo Highway in San Antonio.

The parties have reached a mutual agreement to settle these claims including payment to Ms. Rodriguez in the amount of \$80,000.00, subject to City Council Approval. This amount would be paid from the Self-Insurance Liability Fund.

ISSUE:

Settlements over \$50,000 require City Council approval.

ALTERNATIVES:

If this settlement is not approved by the City Council, this case will proceed to a jury trial. It is in the best interest of the City to settle this matter to avoid the uncertainties and risks associated with litigation in a case of disputed damages.

FISCAL IMPACT:

If approved, \$80,000.00 will be paid to Norma Rodriguez and her attorney of record. This will be funded in accordance with the FY 2018 Liability Fund Adopted Budget.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of this item.
