The following high profile project has completed the solicitation process. This item is presented to the Audit and Accountability Committee for review prior to full City Council for consideration.

**Parking Space Indicator System at the Long Term Garage at SAIA(Aviation/TCI)** - Department released a Request for Competitive Sealed Proposal (RFCSP) seeking qualified and experienced firms to provide and install a parking guidance system in the existing long term garage parking facility, CONRAC surface parking lot and oversized vehicle parking lot.
