SUMMARY:

Approving the following Board, Commission and Committee appointments for the remainder of unexpired terms to expire May 31, 2021 or for the terms shown below.

A) Appointing Nicholas Whelan (District 1) to the San Antonio Youth Commission

- B) Appointing Rob McDaniel (District 8) to the Linear Creekway Parks Advisory Board
- C) Reappointing Russell Persyn (Category: Medina County) to the Conservation Advisory Board

Appointments are effective immediately if eight affirmative votes are received, or ten days after appointment if passed with less than eight affirmative votes.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Applications for District Boards were submitted to the Office of the City Clerk who coordinated review of the applications with the pertinent City Departments and the City Attorney's Office. Qualified applications were forwarded to the respective City Council Offices for their review. A memorandum designating the Councilmember's appointee was submitted to the Office of the City Clerk for processing.
