SUMMARY:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On October 27, 2015 the Housing Commission established three subcommittees that will meet monthly as needed. These subcommittees were formed to more thoroughly explore and develop the recommendations included in the Mayor's Task Force Report and report back to the full Commission. The Resident Retention Subcommittee includes six (6) members from the Housing Commission: Jennifer Gonzalez - Chair, Natalie Griffith - Vice Chair, Jackie Gorman, Jim Bailey, Carol Rodriguez, and Richard Milk.
