- E) Appointing Matthew Bowman (District 8) to the Historic and Design Review Commission for the remainder of an unexpired term of office to expire May 31, 2019.
- F) Reappointing Guadalupe G. Ochoa (District 5) and Juspreet Kaur (District 8) to the San Antonio Public Library Board of Trustees for the remainder of an unexpired term of office to expire September 30, 2020.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:
