- B) Ordinance appointing LaJuana Hill Zanoni (District 10) to the City/County Joint Commission on Elderly Affairs for the remainder of an unexpired term of office to expire May 31, 2019; and waiving the age requirement for this appointment.
- C) Appointing Chris Salas (District 2) to the Disability Access Advisory Committee for the remainder of an unexpired term of office to expire May 31, 2019.
- D) Appointing Adriana C. Segundo (District 2) to the Citizens Environmental Advisory Committee for the remainder of an unexpired term of office to expire May 31, 2019.
- E) Appointing Ranjit Singh Thakurratan (District 2) to the Transportation Advisory Board for the remainder of an unexpired term of office to expire May 31, 2019.
